## 20 feared dead in Zaria over celebration of Buhari's victory

**A**BOUT 20 people were feared dead in Zaria City, Dogarawa and Sabon Gari local councils of Kaduna State while celebrating the victory of President-elect, General Muhammadu Buhari, yesterday.

Among them were four females who were killed when a bus driver lost control of the vehicle and rammed into a crowd at Karauka in Zaria City.

An eyewitness, Shehu Sule, said that many people sustained injuries and are

now receiving treatment at Sidi Dalibi Memorial Hospital in Zaria.

*The Guardian* learnt that about five women also died at Unguwar Juma in Zaria City when another vehicle crashed into a house and killed them. Also, reports had it that nine people died at Dogarawa while celebrating the outcome of the polls.

Another source said two other people lost their lives during the celebration at Tudun Wada in Zaria local council.
