

# Suicide bomber attacks Kano mosque, kills self

## Death toll in Plateau blast hits 44

**A** least one person was reportedly killed in Kano yesterday when a female suicide bomber detonated an explosive device near the popular Ali Bin Abutolib Central Mosque, along Zaria Road in Kano. Eyewitness said the explosive went off at about 9.45pm near the popular mosque but hinted that worshipers had already left the place before the incident occurred.

Although the extent of the damage could not be immediately ascertained, Police Public Relations Officer in Kano, ASP Musa Majiya, who confirmed the development, told journalists that a female suicide bomber on motorbike blew herself up near the central mosque.
