Bayelsa ex-PDP chairman dies, Alaibe denies link to incident

Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) in Bayelsa State, Col. Sam Inokoba (rtd) has passed According to his first son, Waripamowei Inokoba, the officer army retired slumped and died in the wee hours of yesterday in Lagos during a family visit.

"My father slumped at about 2am in the early hours of Wednesday and was confirmed dead before taken to the hospital. Some of our people are on their way to Lagos to bring back his corpse," he disclosed. The late politician, who defected to the All Progressive Congress (APC) some 19 days ago, is believed in some quarters to have died of food poisoning while

others argued that his frail condition suggested stress.

Inokoba had reportedly procured his Expression of Intent and Nomination Forms at the APC secretariat in Abuja to contest the party's primaries ahead of the December 5 governorship election in the state.
