Col. Ayo-Vaughan is dead

A former lecturer at the Nigerian Defence Academy (NDA), Colonel Adedotun Taiwo Ayo-Vaughan (rtd), is dead.

The Army Educational Officer was killed in a ghastly motor accident by a reckless truck driver who drove against traffic along Ijebu-Ode/Ore Expressway, on September 9, 2015, on his way back to Lagos from Benin.

Col. Ayo-Vaughan was born on September 24, 1944 in Lagos to the Late Chief Adenekan and Late Mrs. Bosede Felicia Ayo-Vaughan.

He attended Abeokuta Grammar School and proceeded to the University of Nigeria Nsukka for his Bachelor's degree in education and thereafter bagged a Master degree from the University of Ibadan. He was a teacher at the CMS Grammar School, Lagos and joined the Nigerian Army Educational Corp in 1973.

The Late Col. Ayo-Vaughan retired from the Army in 1995. He is survived by his wife Mrs. Temitope Ayo-Vaughan and four children, including Mrs. Ronke Adesoga, Navy Captain Kayode Ayo-Vaughan, Mrs. Bolanle Johnson and Mr. Gbenga Ayo-Vaughan. Funeral arrangement will be announced later.
