

Tragedy in Agbor, as assailant kills woman

AGBOR town, in Ika South Local Council area of Delta State was thrown into deep mourning last weekend, following the gruesome murder of a middle-age woman by a man simply identified as Sunny.

The assailant, who is presently in police custody, had reportedly laid ambush for the victim for about two days at the particular spot along Agbor-Sakponba Road, where he reportedly dragged her out of her ash-color Toyota saloon car and killed her.

According to a local source, the victim was on her way to a burial ceremony at Oki on the fateful day. The remains of the woman have since been deposited at the mortuary in one of the local hospitals.
