As pro-Biafra protests rocked the South East states of Enugu, Imo, Abia, Ebonyi and Anambra, two policemen were feared killed in Asaba, the state capital of neighbouring Delta State yesterday.

The tragedy occurred when a protest by members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) and the Movement for the Sovereign State of Biafra (MASSOB and Biafra Independence Movement (BIM) turned violent. Unconfirmed reports say 10 of the protesters were killed in the Nkpor area of Anambra State.

Following rumours of the planned protest, the Delta State Police Command had deployed officers in strategic locations in Asaba where they came under attack by irate groups .

Two policemen were killed and two others injured at Cable and Abraka areas and pro-Biafra agitators allegedly made away with one AK 47 assault rifle and one smoke riot gun from the killed and injured policemen.
