Woman arrested for allegedly killing baby in Borno IDP camp

THE Borno State Commander of Nigerian Security and Civil Defense Corps (NSCDC), Ibrahim Abdullahi, has said that a 30-year-old woman was arrested at Dikwa Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) camp for killing her newly born baby last week.

The female IDP (name withheld), according to military authorities yesterday in Maiduguri, allegedly killed the baby by throwing the child into a camp pit.

Abdullahi, while disclosing in Maiduguri to newsmen how the female IDP was ar-

rested in Dikwa town, said: "This incident occurred on June 1, 2016. Immediately she committed the act, she ran out of the Dikwa IDP camp. "Our attention was drawn

to the dastardly act after three days, when the body of the child started to decompose and was smelling from the pit. After we conducted our investigation, we were able to trace her through a man identified as Gulumba, who brought the suspect to the camp."

He said the suspect has been handed over to the Borno State Police Command for prosecution in Maiduguri.
