The Police Prosecutor, Inspector Altine Ragiji, told the court that the incident occurred at Saika village in Bat-

sari Local Council of the state.

According to Ragiji, a traditional ruler in the town reported to the police that a 15-year-old teenage girl (names withheld), gave birth to a child out of wedlock. He explained that upon investigations, Muhammad Bello, 45; Musa Bello, 35; Umar Bello, 27; and the girl's

mother, Faiza Umar, 30, were arrested in connection with

Ragiji revealed that the accused persons, conniving with of the girl's mother, confessed to have killed the baby and gave it to the dog to eat. He said the teenage mother further told the police that she was lured by one Musa Garba, 30, to his farm and forcefully had a sexual intercourse with her about 10 months ago.

"Since then, I missed my men-

struation and later delivered," the girl told the police during investigations.
The accused persons were charged for "an act done with intent to prevent a child from being alive after birth" contrary to sections 85, 235 and 387 of the Penal Code.
The Chief Magistrate, Nura El-Ladan, said the case was brought to the court for cognisance.
