cused committed the offence on June 4 at 3:00 p.m. at No. 4, Ogunmuyiwa Street, Ikate-Itire, Surulere,

Lagos. He said the accused allegedly murdered one Mercy Onuoha, 24, by hitting her head on the wall when Ohklua threw her against the wall.

"The duo engaged a fight over whose turn it was to have their bath in the bathroom in the tenants' apartment.

"In the process, the deceased hit her head against the wall," he said. The offence contravened Section 221 of the Criminal Law of Lagos State, 2011.
