

12 Borno villagers, drivers feared killed in fresh Boko Haram attacks

A member of the Civilian JTF in Borno State, Umar Modu, has said that 12 people were killed in multiple Boko Haram attacks on Wumyeduga village, near Damboa town about 7.45pm on Thursday.

Wumyeduga village is a farming community and 129 kilometres south of Maiduguri, the state capital.

Confirming the incident yesterday in a telephone interview in Maiduguri, Modu said 23 people were also injured in the multiple attacks, which involved the detonation of explosives by a suspected female suicide bomber at the village's cemetery.
