

In another development, it was a gloomy day for residents of Kakangi District in Birnin Gwari Local Council of Kaduna State last Friday as two brothers were allegedly killed by members of the vigilance group in the area.

The police have directed relatives of the deceased persons to immediately report the incident at the Divisional Police Headquarters, Birnin Gwari for proper investigation.

The younger brother of the deceased, Mallam Shehu Rankadede, said the duo, Oli Lafia and Rankadede Nana, had left home for Biski village to perform Juma'at prayers last Friday, but did not return.

According to Rankadede, "since then, we have been searching for them. We learnt members of the vigilance group arrested them. The search yielded positive result as their decomposing bodies were recovered in the bush.

"We are appealing to the Kaduna State government and security agencies to arrest the suspects and bring them to justice without delay. Our brothers were not criminals," he said.

The state PPRO, Mallam Usman Aliyu, said: "Please, tell them to report the incident at the Divisional Police in Birnin Gwari so that investigation will commence."
