

Residents flee Ishawo after militants' invasion

• DPO hospitalised over gunshot wounds

RESIDENTS of troubled Ishawo community in Ikorodu area of Lagos State, have deserted their homes following Sunday's invasion that left no fewer than nine persons, including security operatives dead.

The Guardian gathered yesterday that residents in the area were still fleeing the 'war zone' in droves as they expressed fear of a possible reprisal attack by the military following Sunday's gruesome killing of an Army captain and four policemen attached to Owutu Police Station.

Gunmen numbering about 40 and clad in military camouflages had stormed the area around 1:00a.m. on Sunday and wreaked havoc.
