14 die in Delta auto crash

FOURTEEN persons, including two pregnant women, were feared dead yesterday and several others seriously injured following a head-on collision involving two commercial buses in Ibusa along Asaba-Ogwashi-Uku road in Delta State, involving Delta Intercity and Goddy Agofure

buses.

The injured were taken to hospitals at Ibusa and Asaba immediately after the ghastly auto crash occurred around 3:30p.m.

According to eyewitness report, the state-owned bus, which was on its way to Ogwashi-Uku from Asaba, Delta State capital, had a burst tyre and the driver lost control of the ill-fated vehicle due to a

bad spot on the road before ramming itself into the incoming bus heading from Ughelli.

The state commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Mr. Rindom Kunven, who confirmed the death of the passengers on the spot, said the corps was still collating more details of the accident as at press time yesterday.
