Eight feared dead, 19 injured in Lagos train, Ogun road accidents

NRC to prevent indiscriminate crossing of rail track

It was tragedy in Lagos yesterday as three passengers were crushed by the train in which they were travelling when it collided with a truck that was making an illegal turn on the railway track at Fagba Ojurin, Ifako Ijaye, Abba-torir area.

The victims were hanging on the moving train when the accident happened. They died on the spot, while a yet to be determined number of other passengers sustained severe injuries.
