## Another civil servant commits suicide in Kogi

committed suicide hanging himself on a tree in Lokoja. Soje's body was found on a tree behind the Mammy Market at the Maigumeri Barracks, the Nigeria Army Command Record. The 54-year-old civil servant took his life barely 10 days after his wife of 17 years gave birth to a set of male triplets in a private hospital in Abuja. The couple had been childless before then. Soje, a Grade Level 16 Officer in the Kogi State Teaching Service Commission, was being owed 11 months' salary arrears at the time of death. his
