

## Truck crushes two persons in Ogun State

**T**HE Ogun Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACE) yesterday said two persons lost their lives in an accident that happened along Atan-Idiroko Road.

The Public Relations Officer (PRO) of TRACE, Mr. Babatunde Akinbiyi, told the *News Agency of Nigeria* (NAN) in Ota, that the accident happened around 9.30

a.m.

Akinbiyi said that the truck with an unknown registration number coming from Oke-Odan, Idiroko, lost control due to overspeeding and rammed into a vulcan-

iser and his friend working by the road side.

"The bodies of the victims had been deposited at the morgue at Kayode Hospital at Atan, Ogun, while the

truck driver is in the custody of the police at area," he said.
