

Police corporal allegedly kills bus driver in Ekiti

EKITI State Police Command has arrested one of its men, Cpl. Ayodele Famodimu, who allegedly shot dead a commercial driver on Tuesday. Police spokesperson, SP Alberto Adeyemi, told newsmen in Ado Ekiti yesterday that the incident occurred in Oye

Ekiti, Oye Local Council of the state.

Adeyemi said the policeman killed the bus driver at a checkpoint.

"He is already facing departmental orderly room trial and when the trial is concluded, he will simply be dismissed after which he

will be charged to court," he said.

An eye-witness had, however, told *the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)* that the bus was travelling from Ikara in nearby Ondo State. "When the driver was hit by the bullet, he lost control of the bus and it somersaulted

while the passengers sustained various degrees of injury," the witness said. Also, Mr. Mohammed Olowo, an Assistant Sector Commander at the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Ado Ekiti, said the injuries sustained by the passengers were not critical.
