A MALE suicide bomber blew himself up yesterday at a mosque in Gambouru, Borno State, killing 15 people, including his own father.

Military confident about winning anti-terror war

Haram attack followed Saturday night's assault on a military base in neighbouring Yobe State where five soldiers were allegedly killed, with 30 others missing.

The incident occurred

around 5:00 a.m., as worshippers observed prayers.

The North East Zonal Coordinator of the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA), Bashir Garga, said: "I can confirm

to you that there was an attack in Gambouru Ngala, where 15 people were killed. A male suicide bomber carried out the attack. Some of our officials, the State Emergency Management Agency (SEMA),

the military and the police assisted in the evacuation of over two dozen wounded persons to different medical formations in the town."
