




District, Nafan, Nding Sesut, NYarwai and Lohala in Ropp District where three people lost their lives and many injured."

He added that on May 29, 2018, two people travelling on a motorcycle to visit relatives were ambushed while a woman was equally killed.

Kim lamented that the Miyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association of Nigeria (MACBAN), through its chairman, Mallam Muhammad Nura Abdullahi, was allegedly twisting the narrative by blaming the Berom and Irigwe for reportedly killing and rustling their cows.

In a swift reaction, Abdullahi said on May 25 this year at Kassa village in Barkin Ladi council area, a Berom group attacked cattle rearers and injured two.

The following day, he claimed that at Heipang village, the same group killed seven cows belonging to one Alhaji Abubakar Pooly.
