Amid frantic efforts to restore peace in Taraba, suspected herdsmen again, yesterday, invaded Dinyina village in Takum Council of the state, killing five.

According to local sources, the attackers stormed the sleepy settlement in the wee hours brandishing dangerous weapons. The situation led to residents fleeing to nearby council areas for refuge.

An eyewitness said they were still in bed when the assailants struck, noting: “I believe the casualties would be more than five with a lot of people, especially women and children, missing.”
