Four persons were reported killed in separate attacks by unknown gunmen between Saturday and Sunday in Plateau State. At Arangai village in Mangu council area near the National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) camp, a meat seller, Baba Likita, was on Sunday night killed alongside two other men from Ampang West in same local government.

An eyewitness, who pleaded anonymity, said the attackers were suspected to be Berom from Barkin Ladi Local Council. He explained that the ethnic group believes that any time there was an attack in their community, Mangu serves as a refuge from the marauding herdsmen.

Likita was, however, buried yesterday according to Islamic rites.
