Amnesty indicts government



Oyo govt shuts Bodija market, condoles with victims

Five die in butchers, police clash

A violent protest by members of the National Union of Butchers over the relocation of their abattoir to a new facility in Ibadan yesterday left five persons dead and many others injured.

Also, a police station inside the market was razed by the protesters, while five vehicles parked inside the station were equally burnt, three others outside the premises were completely vandalized. Worried by the move, the state government has ordered immediate closure of the market until further notice.

Trouble started when security operatives from the state police command, deployed to enforce an injunction to seal off the Bodija abattoir were confronted and challenged by the butchers leading to the mayhem that grounded business activities in the entire market.

The government, having completed a modern abattoir at the Amosun village, Akinyele local government area, had ordered all the butchers within the capital city to relocate to the new facility. It had also withdrawn the license of all existing abattoirs in the capital city.

The refusal of some of the butchers to comply led to the government securing a court injunction sealing off the Bodija, Aleshinloye and Sango abattoirs but butchers at the Bodija abattoir were said to have tore off the court order and continued to ply their trades at the market.

The Southwest leader of the butchers union, Mr. Biliaminu Eleshinmeta, urged the state government to investigate those behind the crisis, assuring that only hoodlums hiding under the guise of been members of the association would kick against the MoU signed with the government.
