Police confirms eight persons killed in Borno suicide bomb attack

The Police Command in Borno yesterday confirmed eight persons killed in an early morning suicide bomb attack in a mosque in Konduga Local Government Area (LGA) of the state.

Mr. Edet Okon, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), said in a statement issued in Maiduguri that seven other persons sustained injuries in the attack.

Okon disclosed that a suspected male suicide bomber detonated an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) strapped to his body during an early morning congregational prayer at the Goni Modu Lashibe mosque in Konduga.



The corpses were equally evacuated to the mortuary.




