

Sugar's P.A. dies two weeks after boss' burial

AN aide of Olatoye Temi-tope, a.k.a. Sugar, the slain lawmaker representing Akinyele/Lagelu federal constituency, Wale Azeez, is dead. His death came barely two weeks after his boss, who was gunned down on March 9 during the governorship election at Lalupon area of Ibadan, was buried.

He died on Monday, six days after he was hit by a bullion van whose driver drove against traffic. He was rushed to the Intensive Care Unit of the University College Hospital (UCH), Ibadan while the driver of the bullion van was detained at the Testing Ground Police Station, Iwo road.

The 47-year-old deceased has been the late Sugar's legislative aide since 2011, when the latter was elected to represent Lagelu State Constituency in the Oyo State House of Assembly.
