Another lady found dead in Rivers hotel

A YET-to-be identified female body has been discovered in a hotel room in Port Harcourt, the Rivers State capital. The body of the young woman, suspected to be a sex worker was abandoned in the room with a white piece of cloth tied round her neck.

According to a source, the incident happened on Tuesday, August 13, and the police were invited to evacuate the body when it was discovered. Also, some persons in connection with the murder were arrested while the hotel was shut down.

When contacted, spokesman of the state police command, Nnamdi Omoni, could not immediately confirm the incident.

It would be recalled that this is the second time in two weeks the body of a lady would be found in a hotel in room Port Harcourt. An earlier incident had happened in DiobuLine, a.k.a. D-Line axis of the state two weeks ago. The lifeless body of a lady from Abia State was found in the hotel in the morning after she had checked into the room with a man.

She was also found dead with her tongue gushed out and a piece of cloth tied round her neck, suggesting that she was equally strangled to death, by the yet-to-be identified killer.
