Abiodun Donates To Slain So-Safe Corps Officer's Family

THE Ogun State Governor, Dapo Abiodun has given the sum of N1m to the family of a deceased officer of the state's Community, Social Orientation and Safety Corps Agency (So-Safe Corps), Kehinde Aigbe, who was shot by armed robber while on duty.

Permanent Secretary,

Ministry of Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs, Mr. Kunle Osota, presented the cheque at the Obas' Complex, Abeokuta to the next-of-kin of the deceased, Major Kingsley Aigbe, in the presence of his wife, two children and other members of the family.

Represented by Director of the Local Government Affairs, Olusola Osasona,

Osota recalled that government had earlier spent over N500, 000 on the deceased when he was hospitalised after the attack on June 2, 2019 along Olorunsogo, Oke-Lantoro, Abeokuta.

He said government approved the token to support the immediate family of the deceased for upkeep of the wife and the three children he left behind.
