It was learnt that the bandits also invaded the house of a businessman, Tasiu Wali, where they abducted his wife, Asmau, her one-year-old baby, Husna, and a 20-year-old man, Abu Abu.

Suspected bandits on Sunday night killed a man, Ibrahim Usman, in Jibia town, Jibia

The three were whisked away into the neighbouring Rugu Forest, an area notorious for being used as hideout by bandits.

It was gathered that the incident occurred at about 11pm when the bandits, in their numbers, stormed the town, shooting sporadically to scare residents away.

It was unclear at time of this report if the bandits had called the businessman and asked him to pay ransom for his abducted family members.

The bandits, on their part, agreed to release residents they had kidnapped, especially those living in communities in about eight local council areas situated close to the Rugu
