

Military intensifies attacks on B'Haram hideouts, kills several in Borno

IN furtherance of its mission to restore peace in the North East, the military, through its Operation Lafiya Dole, has intensified attacks on hideouts of the Boko Haram terrorists in Borno State.

The fresh onslaught at Parisu, a major location of the insurgents, within the Sambisa Forest on March 31, followed series of Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR) missions revealing a resurgence of activities within the settlement.

Acting Director, Defence Media Operations, Defence Headquarters, Brigadier General Bernard Onyeuko, yesterday told reporters in Abuja that the deployed fighter jets by the Air Task took turns to annihilate the structures, resulting in the death of several terrorists.
