Tragedy was again recorded in Ibadan, Oyo State, when four persons lost their lives after an articulated truck owned by a dairy firm lost control and crushed a Micra car and three motorcycles.

Eyewitnesses said the incident, which happened at the Alesinloye roundabout on the ever-busy Dugbe Road, was due to a brake failure. Three people died inside the Micra car while one of the motorcyclists died on the spot.

Confirming the incident, the Oyo State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Olugbenga Fadeyi, said: “The bodies of the deceased have been moved to the morgue.
