Despite the payment of N4 million ransom, the boys shot him dead. We recovered six sophisticated rifles, including AK-49, pump action guns and ammunition.

"The gangs used to operate in a guerilla style. They would strike and run far into the bush and resurface. They have been terrorising Southwest zone. These are killers who had the penchant for killing their victims even after collecting ransom. They would go for the passengers and motorists' jugular, but we have been able to end their reign." In another development, lliyasu said the command had arrested a suspected fraudster, Sylvester, who allegedly defrauded a United States-based Nigerian lady of millions of dollars.
