3 In Lagos, suspected hoodlums also took advantage of the #EndSARS protest to unleash mayhem, killing two policemen at Orile Police Station, and setting ablaze 10 police formations across the state.

Media houses like TVC, LTV and Nation newspaper were not spared as they were razed by the furious hoodlums.

Speaking on the attacks, Lagos State police spokesman, Muyiwa Adejobi, told newsmen that the violent hoodlums de-

scended on police stations/facilities and gruesomely murdered two policemen on Tuesday, while others were critically injured.

"Today, Wednesday October 21, the hoodlums again launched series of attack on many facilities within Lagos such as the palace of Oba of Lagos, Shoprite Ajah, Nigerian Port Authority head office, Marina, the governor's mother's house at Akerele, Surulere, VIO/Federal Road Safety Corps offices at Ojodu, Lagos State magistrate courts, Igbosere, TVC station, the Nation Newspapers office, and many other shops/malls.

One of the presenters of

'Your View' programme on TV Continental (TVC), Mrs. Tope Mark-Odigie, narrated how she was rescued with her colleagues when the station and their cars were set ablaze by hoodlums. She mentioned Cypron, a chief-tain of the Oodua Peoples Congress (OPC) in Ketu area of Lagos as the hero of the day.

According to Tope, Cypron and his boys rescued the TVC crew who were on air when the hoodlums attacked, and he took them to his house for safety. Tope added that her car and those of her colleagues were set ablaze along with some other vehicles on the premises.
