

Two Die From Electrical Accident In Ibadan

THE Ibadan Electricity Distribution Company (IBEDC), yesterday, said two persons died at Iwo Road area of Ibadan from electrical accidents.

In a statement, the company said it had begun investigation into the death of a motorcyclist, Mr. Kango

and a passenger, Mrs. Kemi Adegoke, who died on Thursday as a result of electrical accident in Iwo Road area of Ibadan.

The power company said: "The Management of Ibadan Electricity Distribution Company (IBEDC) Plc, hereby, deeply commiserates with

the families of Mr Kango and Mrs Kemi Adegoke, who died as a result of an electrical accident that happened along Iwo/Adogba Road, Oyo State.

"We are currently working with families of the deceased at this difficult period to help

provide some measure of succour. Investigations have begun to ascertain the facts of the case, while all necessary protocols and reports to the regulatory authorities have been initiated. Our team of engineers is already carrying out safety routine maintenance to forestall such occurrences."
