TEANWHILE, the Founder IV Land General Overseer of Success Gate C &S Christ's Church Int'l, Ibode Aseyori, Dr. Ade Ademisokun-Turton, has urged Ondo State government to set up a quasi court for grazing offences.

Ademisokun-Turton stated this, yesterday, in Akure while reacting to the Anti-open Grazing Bill being sent to the House of Assembly by Oluwarotimi Governor Akeredolu, saying the quasi court will help in the administration of justice.

He noted that there should be a mobile court that would try the culprits, stressing that the congestion at regular court may undermine the focus of the law and delay will cause justice denial.
