

Man kills 57-year-old for allegedly sleeping with wife in Adamawa

A 30-year-old father of three, John Samuel, yesterday stabbed a 57-year-old Yaji Lawal to death for allegedly sleeping with his wife.

John, a resident of Bandasarga village in Ganye Local Government Area of Adamawa State, on Sunday, returned home around 1130pm to meet Yaji, a native of a nearby Bakari Guso village, in his house.

"He suspected he came to have an affair with his wife," a police source said.

It was gathered that John immediately pounced on Yaji and stabbed him to death with a knife.

"He left his victim in a pool of his blood," police spokesman, DSP Suleiman Yahaya Nguroje, said.

The victim was said to have been rushed to the hospital where he was confirmed dead. Consequently, the police at-

tached to Ganye division were invited to arrest John.

The Commissioner of Police (CP), Aliyu Adamu Alhaji, while appealing for calm, commended the DPO of Ganye division and his men. He also directed further investigations into the case.

The CP has directed the Deputy Commissioner of Police in charge of State Criminal Investigation (CID) to take over investigation to ensure justice.
