Imo Police Arrests Five Suspected Killers Of Sergeant, Others

¬RACK team of Imo State Police Command has arrested five suspected persons, who killed Police Sergeant Joseph Nwaka and carted away his AK 47 and other arms. Nwaka was attached to Department of Operations

The suspects were also accused of being members of the outlawed Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB)/ Eastern Security Network (ESN).

A statement, vesterday, by the Command's Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Ortando Ikeokwu, a Superintendent of Police (SP), said other items recovered from the suspects were AK 47, four locally-fabricated guns, six rounds of live cartridges and suspected to be Indian hemp.

He said the Command had begun "discreet investigation for further arrest and prosecution." Their arrest took place in Isu Local Council of Imo State. One Onyekachi Mmadufor, of Umudurekwe, Isu, was the first to be arrested.
