Area of Ondo State, while a lady was seriously injured.

The accident happened around 5:00p.m. involving a Toyota Corolla Sports car with APP 91 GR registration number, moving towards Oba-Ile and a bullion van belonging to the Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN) with registration number: JTA 478 AA.

It was gathered that the sports car occupied by two young boys and two ladies, lost control due to over-speeding and crossed the median to hit the van coming from Oba-Ile to Akure City.

Eyewitnesses recounted that the sports car hit the

bullion van, which tumbled and threw the car back to its lane, killing the lady who was sitting in front with the driver instantly as she was flung out of the car.

"The driver, his girlfriend and another guy sitting at the back died instantly while a lady sitting at the back was seriously injured with fractures in her arms and legs.

"The driver of the van and another occupant of the bullion van were safe but had some bruises. We couldn't ascertain the level of the injury because we were attending to the three bodies and survivor who was rushed to hospital for treatment."
