

Gunmen assassinate SEDI MD, orderly in Enugu

GUNMEN again, yesterday evening, killed Prof. Samuel Ndubuisi, managing director of the Scientific Equipment Development Institute (SEDI), Akwuke, Enugu South Council, Enugu State.

Ndubisi was killed with his police orderly in front of the Centenary City on the Enugu Port Harcourt Expressway about 5.50p.m. on his way home after work.

His black Prado Jeep with registration number FG - SEDI -Enugu, was riddled

with bullets, even as his remains and that of his orderly lay along the expressway.

His remains and that of his orderly were moved by security operatives to the University of Nigeria Teaching Hospital (UNTH) morgue.

It was not clear yesterday what could have led to the assassination of Ndubuisi.

The Guardian, however, gathered that his position at SEDI had come under serious threats since the institute was transferred from the Ministry of Science and

Technology to the Presidency.

"In fact, he received an overhead recently which came into several millions of naira, which had never been so before. Several operational vehicles in our office are now bearing the presidency. Our signboard has also changed," the source said.

Efforts to get confirmation from the police on the incident were not successful last night, as the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Daniel Ndukwe,

could not be reached. Ndubuisi's was the second high profile murder in the last three days in the state.
