FOUR members of a roblegedly rob and kill Point of Sales (POS) and Uber operators, have been arrested by operatives of Ogun State Police Command

The suspects, Kehinde Saliu Jelili (also known as Obsomo), Abiodun Akinola, Johnson Fakeye and Jamiu Akinola, were arrested following a report lodged at Onipanu Divisional Headquarters, Sango, on April 18, 2021, by one Aanu Salaudeen, a POS attendant.

According to the statement, Salaudeen reported that her boss, Abiodun Odebunmi, a POS operator, left his office at Aparadija the previous day to meet a customer with a cash sum of N4 million to be used for POS transactions.

She stated further that Odebunmi has not been seen since then, and all calls put across to him did not go through.

According to her, they had

earlier done a transaction of N15 million with the same person who invited his bost to meet him at Opt-Ore to do another transaction of N4 million.

Upon the report, the police men at Onipanu commenced investigation into the sudden disappearance of the man, and their efforts paid off when the dead and burnt body of the victim was discovered in an uncompleted building at the Arobieve area of Ota without trace of his assailants.

According to a statement by the state Police Public Rela-Abimbola Officer, tions Overvenni, the case was transferred to homicide section of the state criminal investigation and intelligence department on the order of the Commissioner of Police, CP Edward Awolowo Ajogun, who mandated the homicide team to unravel the perpetrators of the dastardly act within the shortest possible

The CSP femi Olahode led bomicide ream, in compliance with the CS's directive, embarked on a rechnical and intelligence based investigation, which led them to Oran Ekin in Ekin State, where the suspect was discovered to be hibernating. On getting to Ekin, the suspect got wind of the presence of the detectives and quickly escaped to Offa in Kwata State.

prehend him, the team continued trailing him and they later got information that he was in Senin Republic, where he had gone to attend the court session of Chief Sunday Adeyema, aka Sunday Is boho, and that he would soon be coming to Nigeria."

He said based on information on the date of his return to the country, the team laid an ambush for him and got him arrested at the boundary between Ogun and Lagos states.

On interrogation, Kehinde Salihu Jeili, who claimed to be a native of Apomu in Osun State, confessed to the killing of the victim.

*He confessed further than he deliberately lured the victim to Ora, where he and his gang members were waiting for him with the money he was asked to bring, having transacted a Ni.5m business with him the previous day and that they matcheted him to death after collecting the money from him.
