One dies, 18 others injured in Osun auto crash

NE person yesterday died, while 18 other trayellers sustained injuries in a Ione accident on Osogbo-Tbadan Expressway in Osogbo, capital of Osun State, Public Relations Officer, Osun State Sector of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Mrs. Agnes Ogunvemi confirmed the accident, adding that the crash happened about 1:45p.m. Ogunyemi explained that a white Toyota Hiace marked: EKY 213, lost control due to brake failure and skid off the road.

She said one passenger died while other injured occupants of the bus were rushed to UNIOSUN Teaching Hospi-Osogbo. tal. "The body of the victim has been taken by the family, while the survivors are receiving treatment at UNIO-SUN Teaching Hospital, Osogbo. The incident occurred at about 1:45 p.m. in front of Abere Secretariat first "The incident involved a white Toyota Hiace with Registration number EKY 213. MEANWHILE, the state Sector Commander of FRSC, Mr. Paul Okpe, has appealed to motorists and road users travelling across, during and after Christmas to be cautious to minimise loss of lives through road crashes.

Okpe noted that his command has embarked on safety-awareness campaigns through meetings with the members of National Union of Road Transport Workers (NURTW) and relevant stakeholders with a view to reducing carnage on the road.

The FRSC boss, in a statement issued yesterday by the command's spokesperson, said it is working round the clock, by moving from park to park to campaign against the danger of using worn out tyres, overloading, speeding, consumption of alcohol before and while driving as well as the use of dangerous drugs.

To ensure that the campaign is successful, Okpe said men of the command have been deployed to all roads in the state to ensure safety compliance.
