

ALSO, Amnesty International, Nigeria has condemned the killing of 25 villagers and destruction of their property by herders at Maraba, Adan and Agban Gida communities in Kagoro Village of Kaura Council of Kaduna State.

The development compelled the state government to impose curfew in parts of the state. Commissioner for Internal Security and Home Affairs, Samuel Aruwan, said: “Following advice from security agencies, the Kaduna State Government has declared a 24-hour curfew in Jema’a and Kaura councils to enable security agencies to stabilise the areas, save life and property and restore law and order.”

But Country Director, Amnesty International Nigeria, Ossai Ojigho, lamented that despite the intervention of security officers, the attack in Kagoro lasted over two hours, and displaced several households in three communities.
