Bamidele was said to be on duty that fateful day, when a group of Micra drivers jointly attacked and killed him, after obstructing an erring commercial driver.

"While on duty at New Roundabout. Garage Ibadan, one AP/NO. 16860 STW Oluniyi Bamidele stopped a Micra commercial vehicle for obstruction and immediately the driver learnt that he was to be taken to the station, he came down from the vehicle and pretended to have fainted.

"His action attracted other Micra drivers who joined him and attacked the police officers till one of them managed to escape, while his colleague who was unable to escape was mobbed."
