

Soludo Condemns Killing Of Three Vigilance Group Operatives At Igbo-Ukwu

ANAMBRA State Governor, Chukwuma Charles Soludo, has condemned in very strong terms the killing of three operatives of Anambra State Vigilance Group, who were on official duty at Nkwo, Igbo-Ukwu, Aguata Local Council.

The victims were identified as Okeke Emeka, Nnayelu Orizu and Chukwuma Ubaego.

While condemning the dastardly killings, the governor in a statement by his Press Secretary, Christian Aburime,

reiterated that those responsible for the killing of the three men would be fished out to face justice.

"This particular act of killing is inhuman and totally unacceptable. The perpetrators will surely not go scot-free, as we are fully determined to fish them out to pay dearly for their crimes," Soludo reassured.

He reassured that those who attacked Senator Ifeanyi Ubah's convoy and some military personnel would equally be apprehended to face the full wrath of the law.
