Borno: Eight Killed As Farmers, Herders Clash In Bayo

THE clashes between farmers and herders over alleged encroachment on farmlands have claimed eight lives in Bayo Local Council of Borno State.

The council, with a population of over 78, 900, is located

237 kilometres south of Maiduguri, the state capital.

A counter-insurgency expert in the Lake Chad Region, Zagazola Makama, on Friday, disclosed: "The people were killed after an argument by some farmers over an encroachment of their farm-

lands with cattle."

He said the crops were yet be harvested and evacuated to the granaries.

He added that on November 30, 2022, another set of pastoralists encroached and led the cattle to eat up their crops.

Makama further said several farmers were also hospitalised and security agencies were alerted.

He noted that deployment of security personnel stopped the attacks from further spreading to other farmlands.
