Two men to die by hanging for killing, robbing okada rider in Osun

N Osun State High A Court sitting in Osogbo, yesterday, sentenced two persons, Mutiu Azeez (a.k.a Tompolo) and Afolabi Mayowa, to death by hanging for armed robbery and other offences.

The convicts were arraigned before Justice Jide Falola on December 2, 2018 on four count-charge bordering on conspiracy to commit armed robbery. armed robbery, conspiracy to murder and murder.

The offenCes contravened sections 6(b), (2) (a), (b), of the Robbery and Firearms (special provisions) Act, Cap R11, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria,2004, sections 324, and 319 of the Criminal Code, Cap 34, Volume 2. They were said to have forced the motorcyclist down from his motorcycle and collected the key of the bike from him. The convicts were said to have tied his neck to a tree before hitting his head with a stone.

The convicts were said to have confessed that they killed Mavowa because he knew one of them. Afterwards, they were said to have robbed the victim of N1,400 and his bajaj motorcycle.

The convicts according to the prosecution, rode the stolen motorcycle to Osogbo where Mutiu Azeez gave Afolabi the sum of

600 as his transport fare to Iragbiji while Mutiu Azeez took the motorcycle to Ibadan and sold it at the rate of 120,000. NSCDC arrests 65year-old man for raping 11-year-old orphan

THE Nigeria Security and L Civil Defence Corns (NSCDC) have arrested a 65year-old man for allegedly raping an 11-year-old orphan repeatedly.

The Command also paraded five suspects including two ex-convicts who specialise in killing motorcycle owners before disposing of their machines.

Also, a female money counterfeiter and five-sex workers were paraded, yesterday, the Command.

The alleged rapist, Elam Gari, a father of eight from Shongom local council of Gombe State was said to have sexually molested the girl (names withheld.)

According to the NSCDC Commandant, Waziri Gona, the culprit who often took the girl to a bush, always threatened to kill her, if she disclosed the illicit affairs to anyone including her guardian.

He told newsmen that Elam usually came from down Labariya to upper Labariya, searching for the poor girl before taking advantage of her in a nearby
