ERRORISTS, morning, killed three persons, including a woman working at the local clinic in the community, and abducted six others, including a pregnant woman, at Jajar Kanwa village in libia Local Council of Katsina State.

The source said that many people sustained injuries while trying to flee from the terrorists.

He said that before the terrorists left, they told the residents to pay N20,000 each within one week or face their wrath.

The Guardian gathered that most of the residents are peasant farmers.

The source, therefore, called on government and security operatives to come to their rescue.

Spokesperson for the Katsina police command, SP Gambo Isah, who confirmed the incident, however said only two people were killed and three injured.
