Death toll exceeds 100 in Plateau onslaught

From Isa Abdulsalami Ahovi, Jos EATH toll in villages of Mangu Council of Plateau State has risen to more than 100 persons.

Acommunity leader in hiding, Dan Mangu, made the disclo-

sure.

He said: "I am hiding now. The situation is worse again. The Fulani people brought in mercenaries to kill us. But we don't have anybody to help us, except God. The security is overwhelmed. They are not helping us.

"The death toll is more than 100. We are talking about 150

now."

Mangu noted that almost all buildings in the village had been destroyed and the attackers virtually taking over Gindiri town.

It was gathered that a mass

burial had taken place.

This is even as a security team has arrested five suspects in connection with gruesome murder of women and children in Fungzai and Kubwat villages within same local council.

Spokesman for the state police command, DSP Alfred Alabo, in a statement, said the suspects are in custody of Special Task Force (STF) code-named Operation Safe Haven (OPSH).
