**\*Adeleke declares curfew over crisis**

THE police in Osun State, yesterday, appealed to indigenes of Ilobu and Ifon Orolu communities to remain calm and refrain from taking law into their hands over the killing of one Alamu. *The Guardian* learnt that 28-year-old Alamu was killed along Opapa village in Ilobu on Saturday. Alamu hailed from Aganna compound in Ilobu, Irepo-

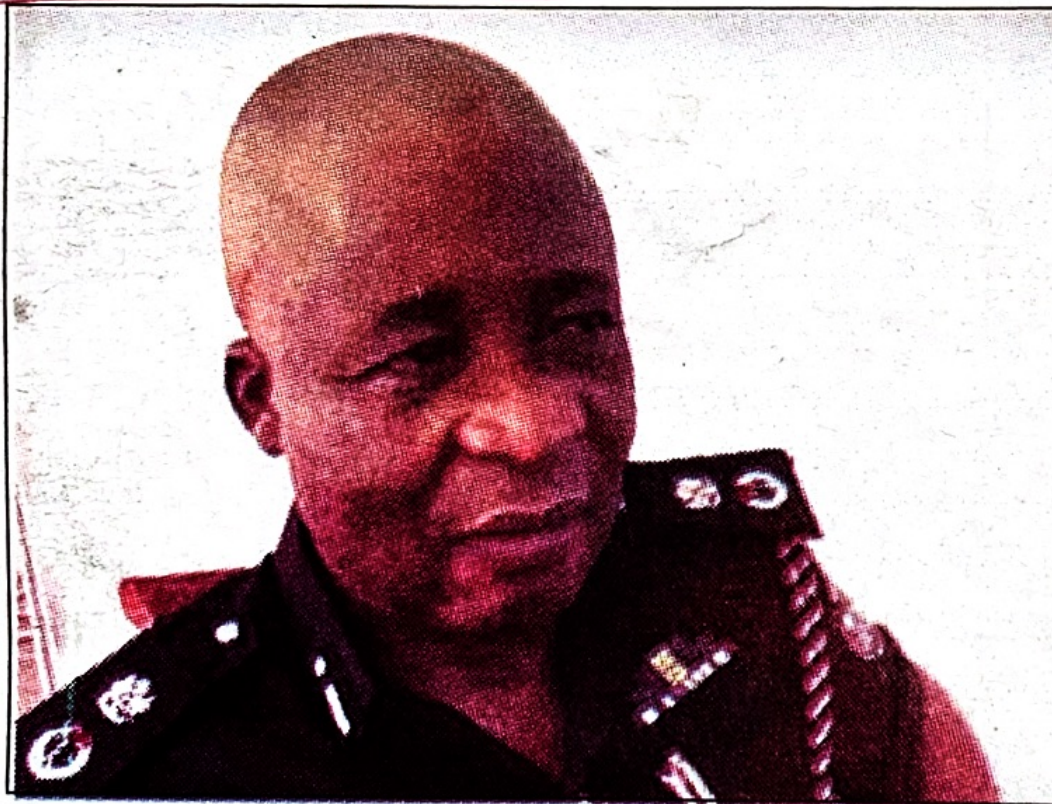
dun Local Council of Osun State.

The Commissioner of Police, Patrick Kehinde Longe, in a statement by the Command's spokesperson, Yemisi Opalola, confirmed that the police were aware of the incident.

He said investigation has commenced to unravel the circumstances leading to Alamu's death.

The police boss also said the command was aware of clandestine meetings by some groups of people, who are plotting to cause mayhem over the development.

Longe said he has been having meetings with the traditional ruler in Ilobu, the Olobu of Ilobu, and relevant stakeholders to ensure that peace reigns in the area.
