

Police recover body of missing 26-year-old woman in Abuja

Police operatives in Federal Capital Territory (FCT), Abuja, have recovered the body of a 26-year-old woman, Blessing Karami Moses, who had been missing since September 11.

Police spokesperson, Josphine Adeh, who confirmed the development, said the body was discovered in the Karimo area of the FCT.

She said: “Her disappearance was reported to the authorities on September 14.

“We wish to inform the public that our primary focus at this time, under the directive of the FCT Commissioner of Police (CP), Haruna Garba, is to conduct a thorough and impartial investigation into circumstances surrounding the victim’s untimely death.

“Our commitment to this case is unwavering, and we are determined to uncover both immediate and remote causes of this tragic incident.

“While we are working closely with the Abuja Environmental Protection Board (AEPB) to facilitate the retrieval of the decomposed remains acknowledging the sensitive nature of this task, we will continue to provide updates to the public as investigation progresses.

“Our thoughts are with the family and loved ones of Blessing Karami Moses, during this difficult time,” She added.
