At least, six persons have lost their lives in fresh attacks in Plateau State, barely a week that over 190 persons were slaughtered in the state.

Suspected Fulani militia reportedly attacked Kwahaslalek Community in Mangu Local Government Area (LGA), yesterday, around 1.00a.m.,killing three persons and leaving two injured.

The attacked community is behind the permanent site of the National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) Camp in Mangu.

According to a source, the situation remained very tense, as military and other security agencies were trying their best to calm the situation
