

Ambulance driver dies in collision with articulated truck in Lagos

An ambulance driver has tragically lost his life in a road accident in the TREM/Anthony area of Lagos State.

The collision involved an ambulance with registration number JBD-405HA and an articulated lorry with an unknown registration number.

According to reports, the lorry was struck on its side while in motion, causing the driver to lose control and swerve into another lane. The sudden manoeuvre resulted in a collision with the approaching ambulance, which crashed into the lorry at high speed.

The ambulance driver was

trapped inside the vehicle and tragically died at the scene.

The Lagos State Emergency
Management Agency
(LASEMA) swiftly responded
to the incident, dispatching
its Response Team from the
Cappa Base in Oshodi and
other emergency respon-

ders.

Traffic management measures were implemented to control the flow of vehicles, and LASEMA deployed heavy and light-duty equipment, including Super Metro and Lite Tow Trucks, to clear the road and ensure public safety.
